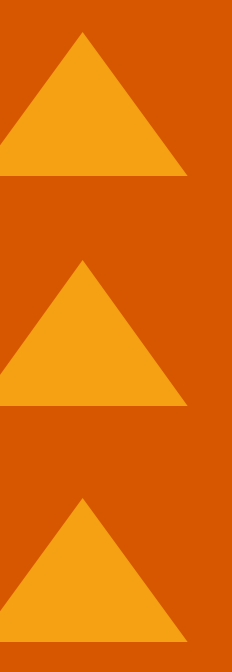

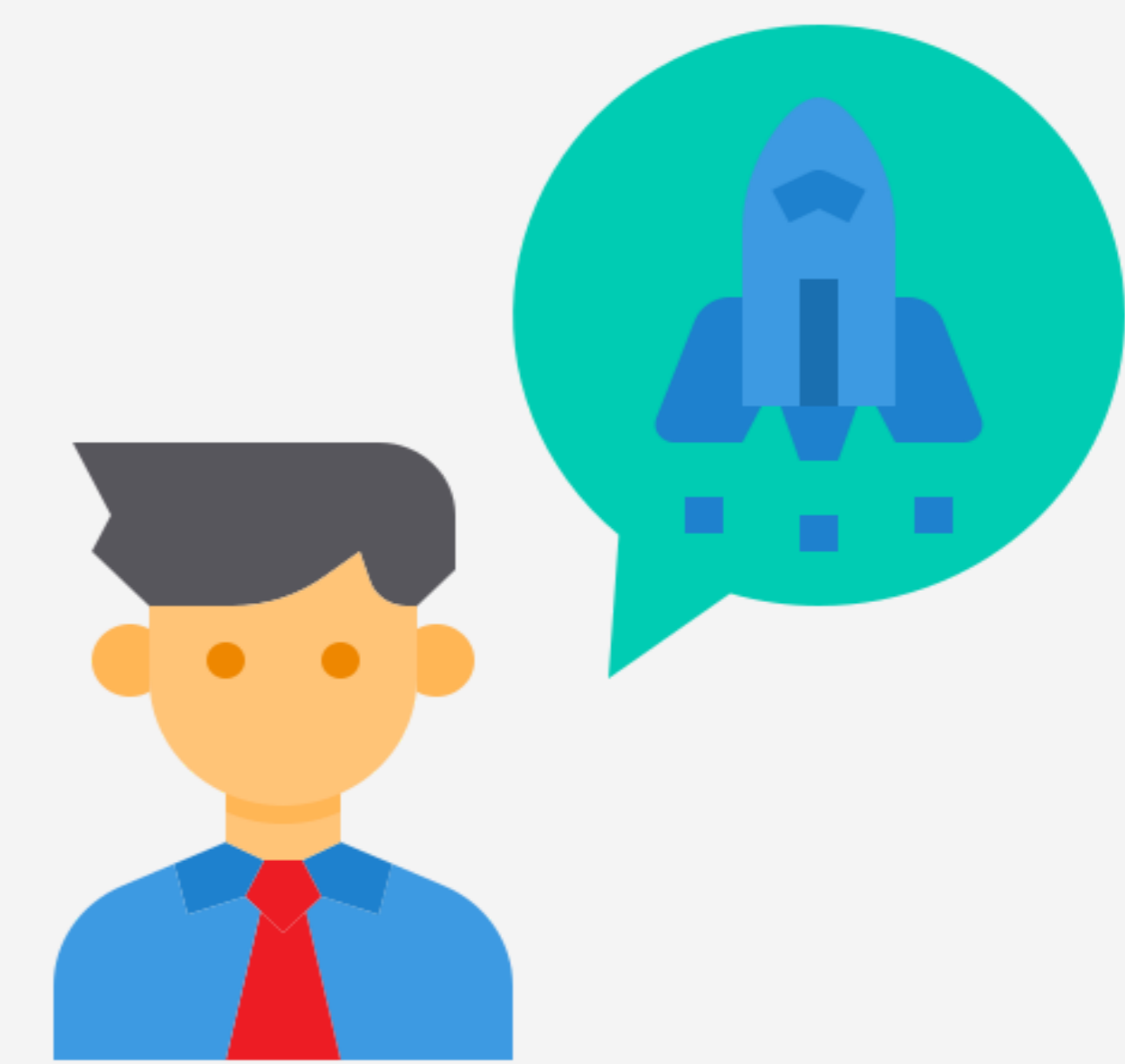
JOBS SUPPORT SCHEME (JSS)



Provide wage support of up to 75% on the first \$4,600 of gross monthly wages, for more than 150,000 firms employing over 2 million local workers, with total coverage of up to 17 months

To help employers retain workers and provide increased support for affected sectors

ENHANCED STARTUP SG FOUNDER PROGRAMME



Enhance the Startup SG Founder Programme in phases, through raising of startup capital grant and Government matching ratio as well as introducing venture building programmes

To boost pipeline of new innovative startups and entrepreneurs

SGUNITED JOBS & SKILLS PACKAGE

Includes Career Conversion Programmes, SGUnited Traineeships, SGUnited Mid-Career Pathways (Company Attachments/Company Training), SGUnited Skills

To open up more than 100,000 jobs, traineeships, and upskilling opportunities for local jobseekers



Jobs Growth Incentive

Support firms to increase headcount of local workers through co-funding up to 50% of the first \$5,000 of gross monthly wages for new local hires for up to 12 months

To support firms to create jobs and hire jobseekers



Enhanced Training Support Scheme

Enhanced course fee subsidies (select sectors) and higher absentee payroll rates for eligible employer-sponsored training

To support firms in using the downtime to reskill and upskill their employees

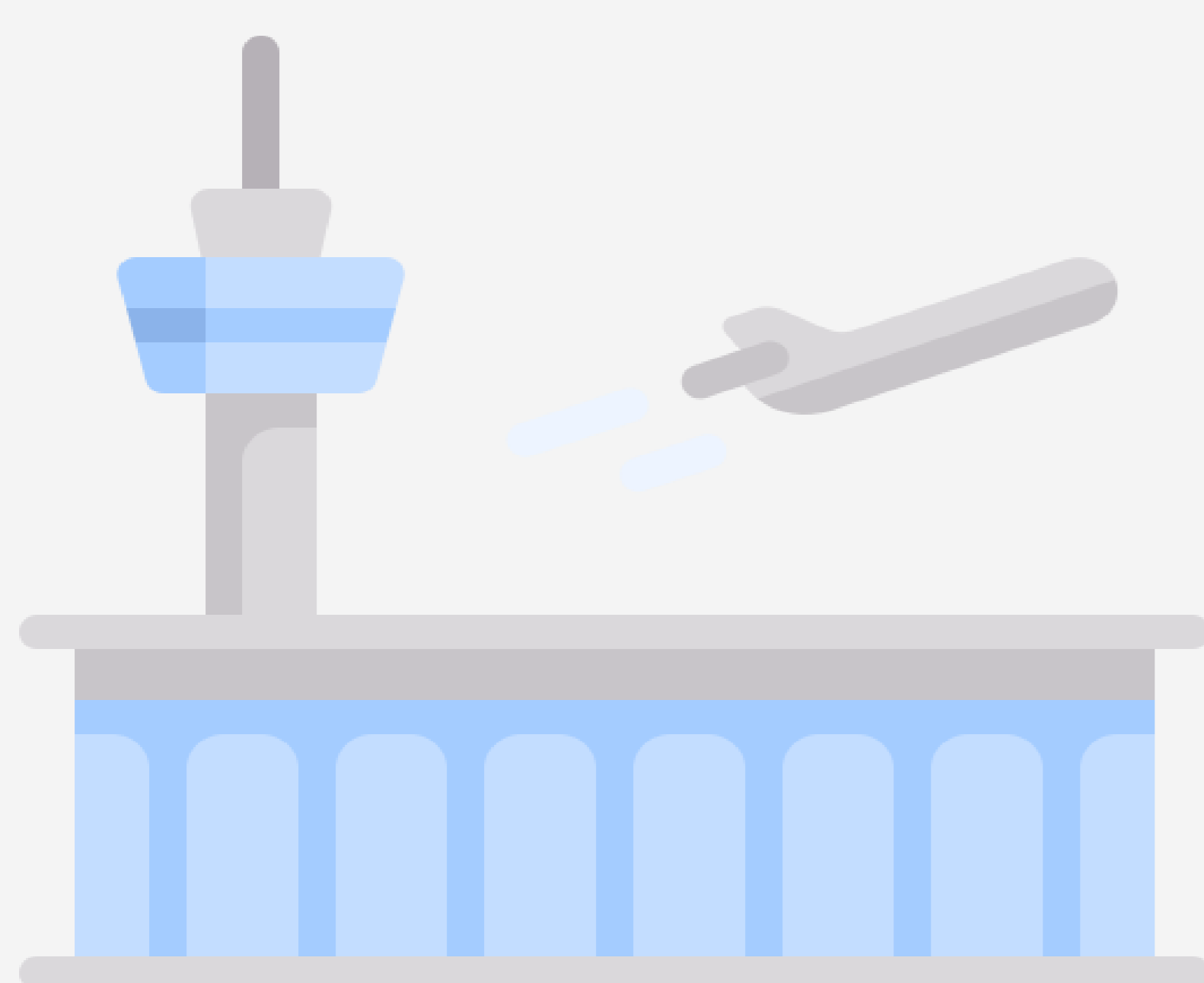
REBATES, WAIVERS & FINANCING SCHEMES FOR ENTERPRISES



Provide property tax rebate, corporate income tax rebate, foreign worker levy waiver & rebate, rental relief, and new/enhanced schemes to help Singapore enterprises access financing in areas such as working capital, trade and projects (e.g. Temporary Bridging Loan Programme, enhanced Enterprise Financing Scheme)

To help businesses manage cost and cashflow, and access credit

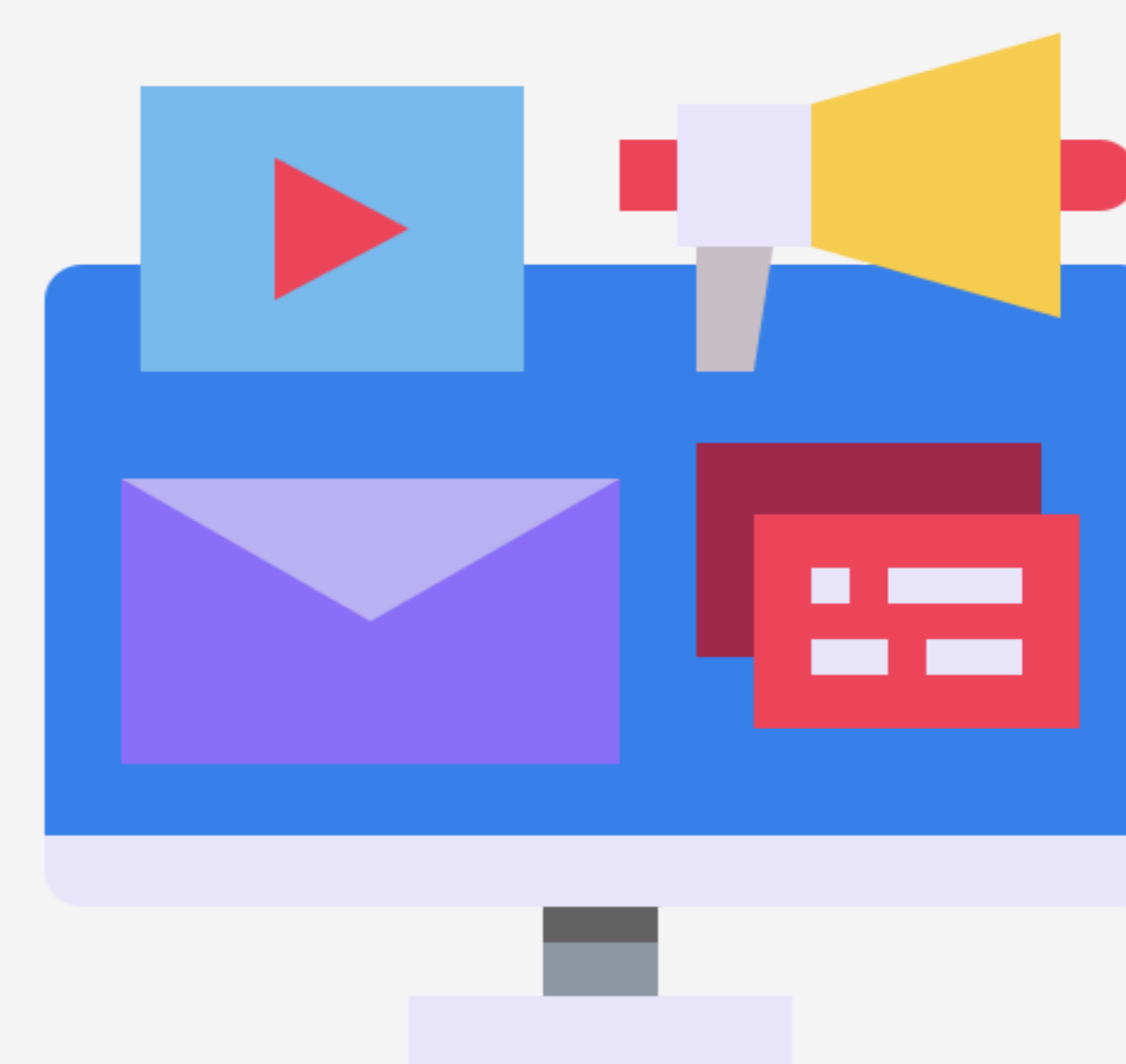
AVIATION SUPPORT PACKAGE



Provide cost relief for our airlines, ground handlers, cargo agents and airport tenants

To regain Singapore's air connectivity to the world and retain core capabilities

CAPABILITY BUILDING GRANTS/ ENTERPRISE GROW AND TRANSFORM PACKAGES



Includes the Market Readiness Assistance Grant, Productivity Solutions Grant, Enterprise Development Grant, PACT Programme, Digital Resilience Bonus, SMEs Go Digital Programme, and Enterprise Leadership for Transformation Programme

To help businesses internationalise, transform and digitalise

SINGAPOREDISCOVERS VOUCHERS



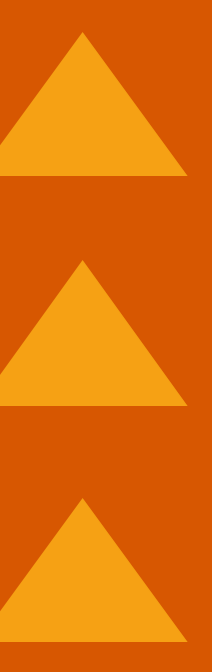
Issue \$100 worth of SingapoRediscovered vouchers for each Singapore citizen (aged 18 years and above as at 31 Dec 2020), that can be used on hotel stays, attraction tickets, or tours

Provide subsidies for child/youth tickets for attractions and tours

To boost local tourism

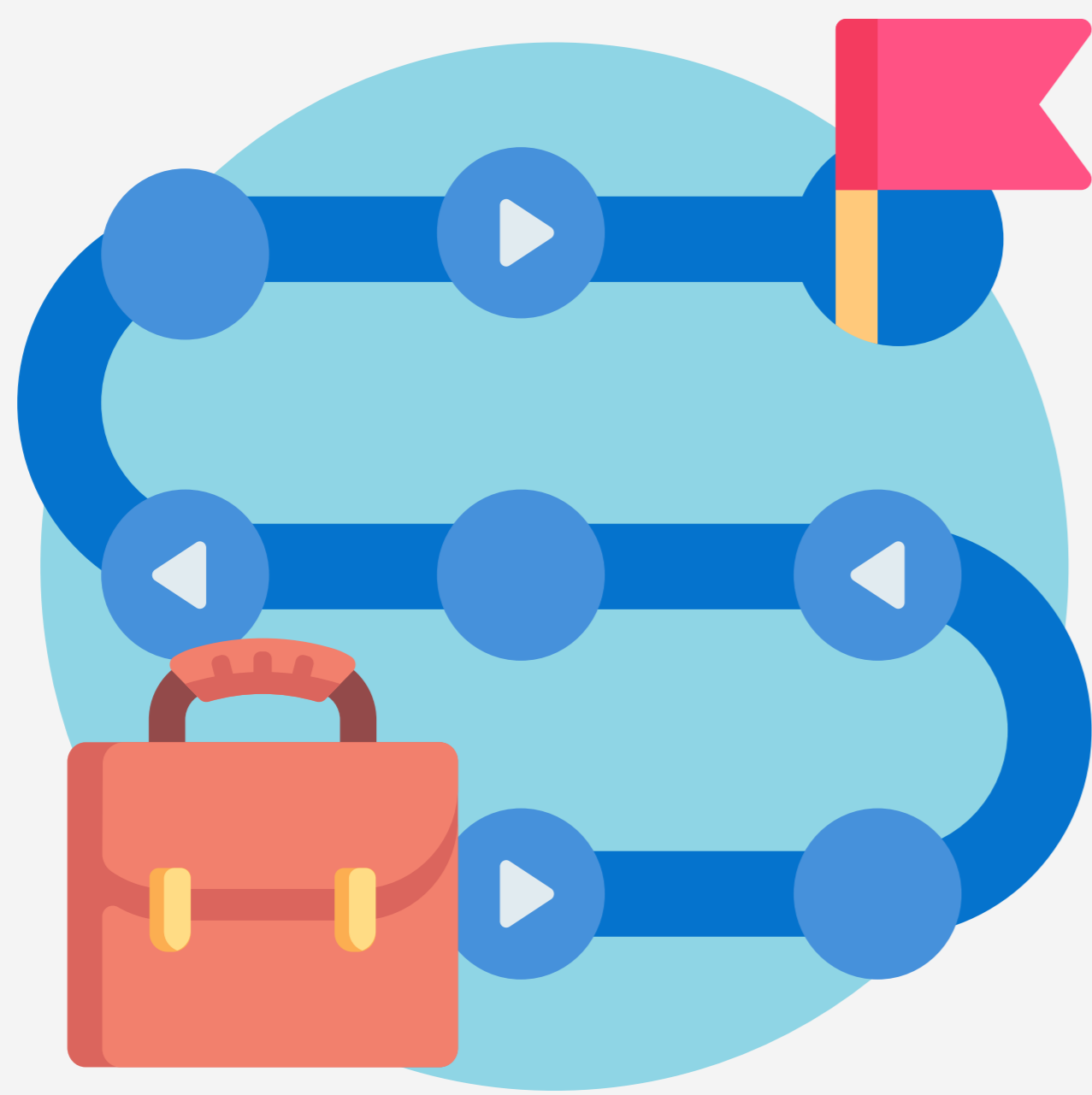

GLOBAL READY TALENT PROGRAMME



Pipeline of global-ready talent for Singapore enterprises through exposing more Singaporeans to internships and overseas work opportunities

To groom talent to support business expansion plans both locally and in overseas markets

GLOBAL INNOVATION ALLIANCE



Network of Singapore and overseas partners in major innovation hubs and key demand markets

To connect companies to overseas business and technology communities

TECH SKILLS ACCELERATOR (TeSA)



Tripartite initiative by the Government, Industry and NTUC that includes the Tech Immersion and Placement Programme (TIPP), Critical Infocomm Technology Resource Programme Plus (CITREP+), and TeSA Company-Led Training

To develop more local ICT professionals in emerging skill areas and enhance employability outcomes in the ICT profession
