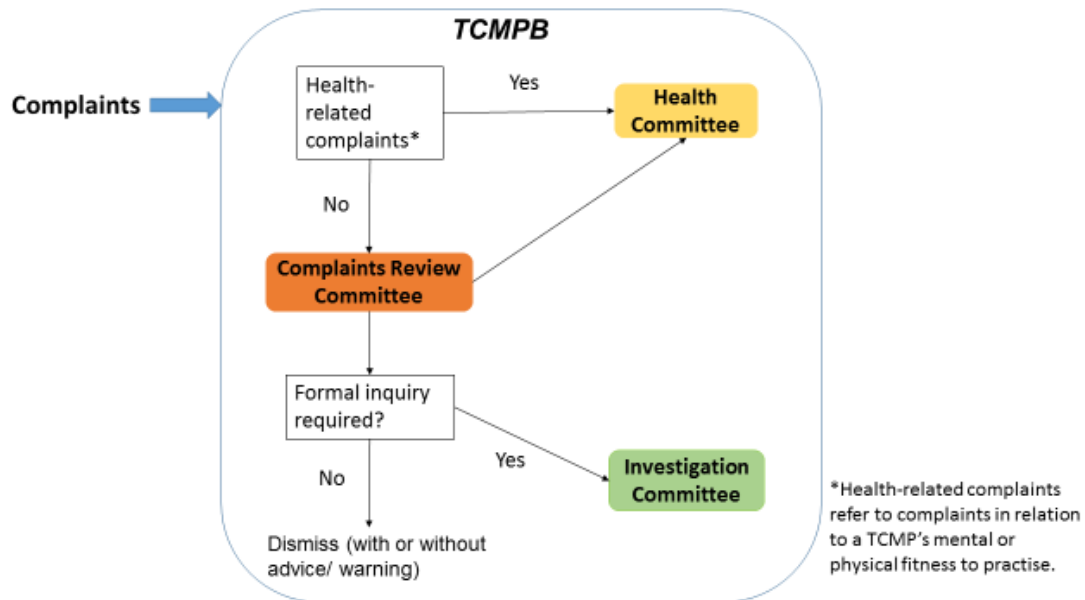


Proposed Disciplinary Framework under the Amended TCMPA**Disciplinary Process**

- With the TCMPA amendment, the TCMPB will refer complaints concerning matters such as a breach of the TCMPA, professional misconduct or negligence to a Complaints Review Committee (CRC). The CRC will carry out preliminary investigations and submit its findings and recommendations to the TCMPB on whether a formal inquiry by an Investigation Committee (IC) or Health Committee (HC) is necessary.
- Where the CRC determines that an inquiry by an IC or a HC is necessary, the TCMPB will appoint an IC to hear and investigate the complaint, and make a recommendation on the appropriate penalty.

IC

The role of the IC is to investigate into any alleged breach of conditions of registration of a registered practitioner or a disciplinary matter under the Act, i.e. professional misconduct or negligence.

HC

The role of the HC is to conduct health inquiry in respect to the TCMP's mental and physical fitness to practice.
