Annex B – Illustrative and Non-Exhaustive Examples of Extremely Harmful Content That May Require Access to Be Disabled for Users in Singapore

Suicide and	Content that encourages or amounts to endorsing suicide and self-harm
self-harm	 Encourages or amount to endorsing physical harm to self (including acts that could result in death) or serious physical injury Provides instructions on how to cause physical harm to self, including acts that could result in death or serious physical injury
Sexual harm	Content that encourages or amounts to endorsing the commission of sexual harm
	 Encourages or amount to endorsing sexual violence, or sexual activity involving coercion or non-consent
	Content that encourages or amount to endorsing the sexual abuse of young persons
Public health	Content that has the tendency to endanger public health Content that promotes or encourages the use of regulated substances or pharmaceutical drug products for unsubstantiated purposes, which may or have the tendency to endanger public health
Public security	 Content that has the tendency to threaten or undermine public security Encourages, amounts to endorsing, or glorifies acts of terrorism Encourages, amounts to endorsing, or glorifies violence against persons Provides instructions on how to commit acts of violence against persons
Racial or	Content that has the tendency to cause racial or religious disharmony or
religious	intolerance
disharmony or	Content that denigrates a religious or racial group in Singapore
intolerance	 Negative and egregious comparisons, defacement, or destruction of religious emblems
