2018 Budget Statement to be delivered on Monday, 19 February 2018

Singapore's FY2018 Budget Statement will be delivered by the Minister for Finance, Mr Heng Swee Keat, on Monday, 19 February 2018 in Parliament.

2 There will be live television and radio coverage of the Budget Statement. A live webcast of the delivery of the Budget Statement will be available on the Singapore Budget Website (www.singaporebudget.gov.sg). The Budget Statement will be uploaded on the Singapore Budget website after the speech has been delivered.
